



## Permanent Makeup Healing Schedule Eyeliner

### Eyeliner Day & Effect

#### **Day 1:**

The eyeliner is approximately 25-35% darker and bolder than they will be when healed. It will look like a “heavier” eye makeup look. You will be swollen and your skin is red under the pigment, which causes the color of the pigment to appear darker and the pigment is fresh. There is some swelling, this will subside. Exfoliation/Shedding will begin in a few days. Cold compresses will help with any discomfort and swelling.

#### **Day 2:**

Swollen, usually for only a few hours after waking up, with the heavier eye makeup look continuing. Again, if swelling is still present – cold compresses applied will help bring this down. You may appear pink above the eyelid area – this will subside in a few days.

#### **Day 3:**

Swelling decreases with a tight feeling. The pigment begins to lift away from the skin. **DO NOT PICK!** Apply balm/Vaseline/Aquaphor at night and as needed during the day to keep it moist.

#### **Day 4:**

There is a “pinching” feeling. Some itching is normal as the skin begins to flake. **DO NOT PICK!** Again – continue applying balm/Vaseline/Aquaphor as needed.

#### **Day 5 - 7:**

Blinking movements of the eye usually removes all pigment by this day. Color is somewhat “grayish” and will take a few more days to clarify to full color.
